International vision	<p>Through international programmes and exchange agreements with <b>170 business schools worldwide (47 countries)</b>, IESEG is building an international classroom to prepare future managers to be members and leaders of multicultural teams.</p> <p>IESEG represents an international community of students and faculty members. <b>English is the working language at IESEG</b>: the Master's program is entirely taught in English (this is unique in France), 70% of permanent professors are international and faculty members represent 15 different nationalities.
